# PLAYING THE GAME

## HOW IT WORKS

DJ Wild Stud Poker is a five card poker game played with a fifty-two card deck and one Joker. The Joker and all deuces are fully wild. All hands with a Deuce are not considered "Wild." If the Deuce is not used as a Wild card to make a winning trips or better hand, it will be considered natural.

Before any cards are dealt for a round of play, a player must make an Ante bet equal to the Blind bet. There are 2 optional side bets "Trips" and "Two-Way Bad Beat." After the players are dealt their 5 card hand, they must choose to either fold their hand or make a play bet of 2 times of their Ante bet.

Full House	40 to 1	5 to 1
Flush	25 to 1	4 to 1
Straight	20 to 1	3 to 1
Trips	7 to 1	1 to 1
