# PLAYING THE GAME

## HOW IT WORKS

Texas Hold'Em Bonus Poker is a variation of the popular televised poker game of Texas hold'em. There are five permissible bets. They are the Ante, Flop, Turn, River and the Bonus bet. Players play against the dealer's hand with the exception of the Bonus bet which is based on each player's first two cards.

The game starts with players making an Ante bet and the optional Bonus bet. The pay table for the Bonus bet is as follows:

Players Two Card Hand	Payout Odds
Ace - Ace	30 to 1
Ace - King (suited)	25 to 1
Ace - Queen or Ace - Jack (suited)	20 to 1
Ace - King (unsuited)	15 to 1
King - King, Queen - Queen, or Jack - Jack (high pairs)	10 to 1
Ace - Queen, or Ace - Jack (unsuited)	5 to 1
Ten - Ten, through Two - Two (low pairs)	3 to 1

Players will be dealt their two cards and will then decide to place the Flop bet or to fold. The Flop bet must be twice the amount of the Ante. The dealer will deal three community cards out and expose them as the flop. Players may now choose to check or place a Turn wager which must be the same amount as the Ante bet. The dealer will deal a fourth community card called the Turn card which will be exposed also.

Players may now choose to check or to make a River wager which must be the same amount as the Ante bet. The dealer will deal the fifth community card or River card and expose it. The dealer will expose their two-card hand and using their two cards and the five community cards, will indicate the best five-card hand.

Each player's cards will be exposed in order and the combination of their two cards along with the five community cards will be used to create the best five card poker hand. Each player's five-card hand will be compared to the dealer's five-card hand. If the player's hand beats the dealer's hand then the Flop, Turn, and River bets will be paid even money. The Ante will only be paid if the player's winning five-card hand is a Flush or better.

The Bonus bet payouts will also be completed regardless of whether the player's hand wins or lose

Texas Hold'Em Bonus Poker also offers a progressive bonus bet that is described in the progressive jackpot rules of the game.
