# HOW 10 PLAY 2-3-5 STUD POKER 

YOUR GUIDE TO PLAYING CASINO TABLE GAMES


## Playing THE GAME

## HOW IT WORKS

2-3-5 Stud Poker is a five-card poker game played with one 52 card deck against a pay table and not against the dealer or other players. Each player will receive three cards and use the two community cards to make their best five-card poker hand. 2-3-5 Stud Poker also offers the optional Hat Trick bonus wager.

## GETTING STARTED

Make equal wagers on the bet spots marked 2
Card Poker, 3 Card Poker, and 5 Card Poker. You may also make the Hat Trick bonus wager. Once all wagers have been made, the dealer will give each participating player their two-card starting hand to review.

You now have a choice:

1. Make an equal wager on the Raise bet spot under your 3 Card Poker bet.
2. Or check.

Once you have made your Raise wager or decided to check, the dealer will give players their 3rd card to review.

You now have a choice:

1. Make an equal wager on the Raise bet spot under your 5 Card Poker bet.
2. Or check.

The dealer will now turn the two community card face up.

## WINNING AND LOSING

Starting from their right and working counterclockwise, the dealer will reveal each player's three card poker hand and combine them with the two community cards to make the best five-card poker hand.

Payouts are based on rank of your 2-card poker hand, 3 -card poker hand and 5-card poker hand. See layout for odds.

Note: All winning wagers pay odds.

## HAT TRICK

Your Hat Trick wager wins if you win all three wagers. See layout for odds.

2-3-5 Stud Poker also offers a progressive bonus bet that is described in the progressive jackpot rules of the game.

| Flush | 20 to 1 |
| Straight | 15 to 1 |
| Three of a <br> Kind | 7 to 1 |
| Two Pair | 3 to 1 |
| Tens or <br> Better | 1 to 1 |
